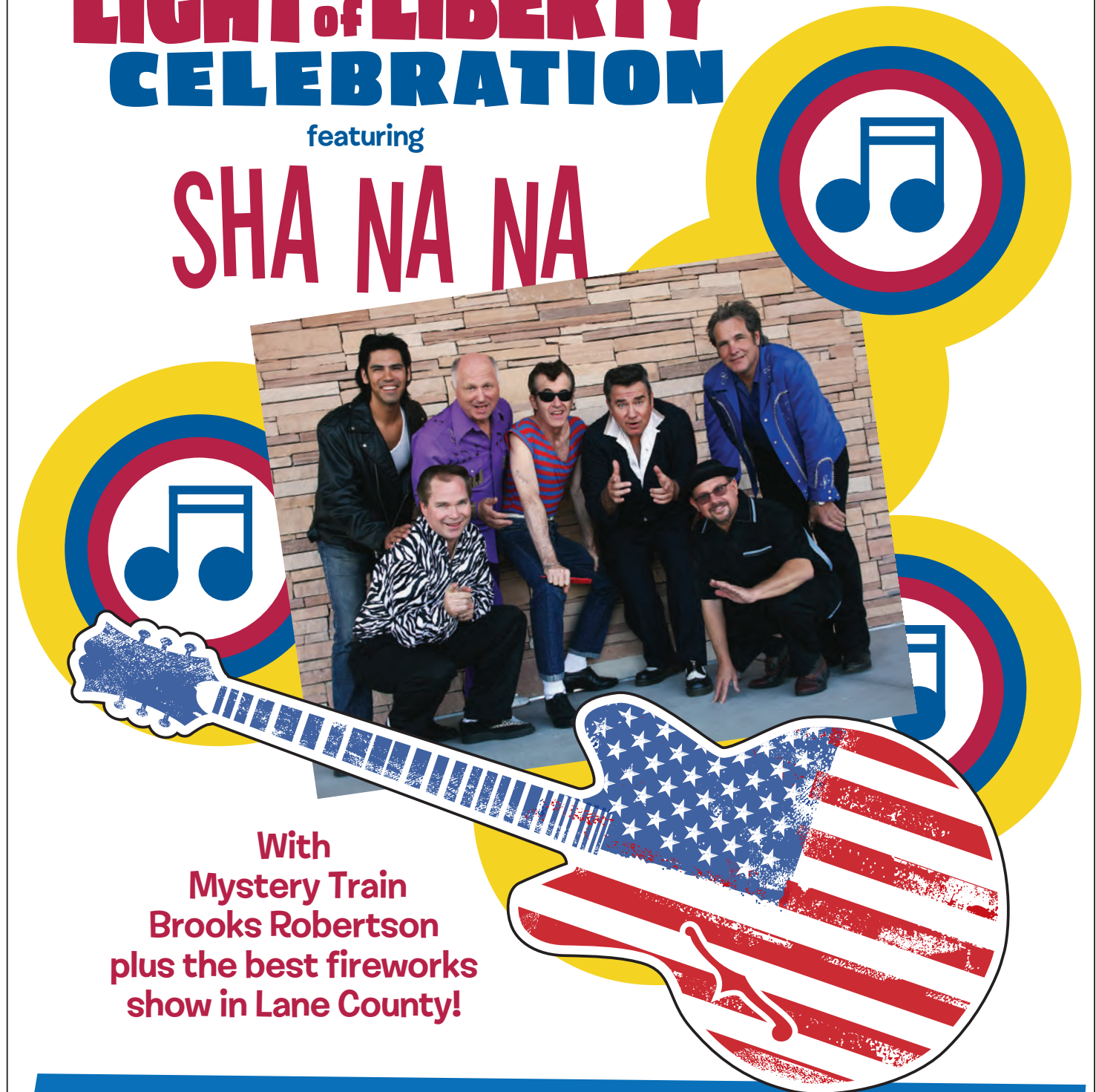

Food Vendors

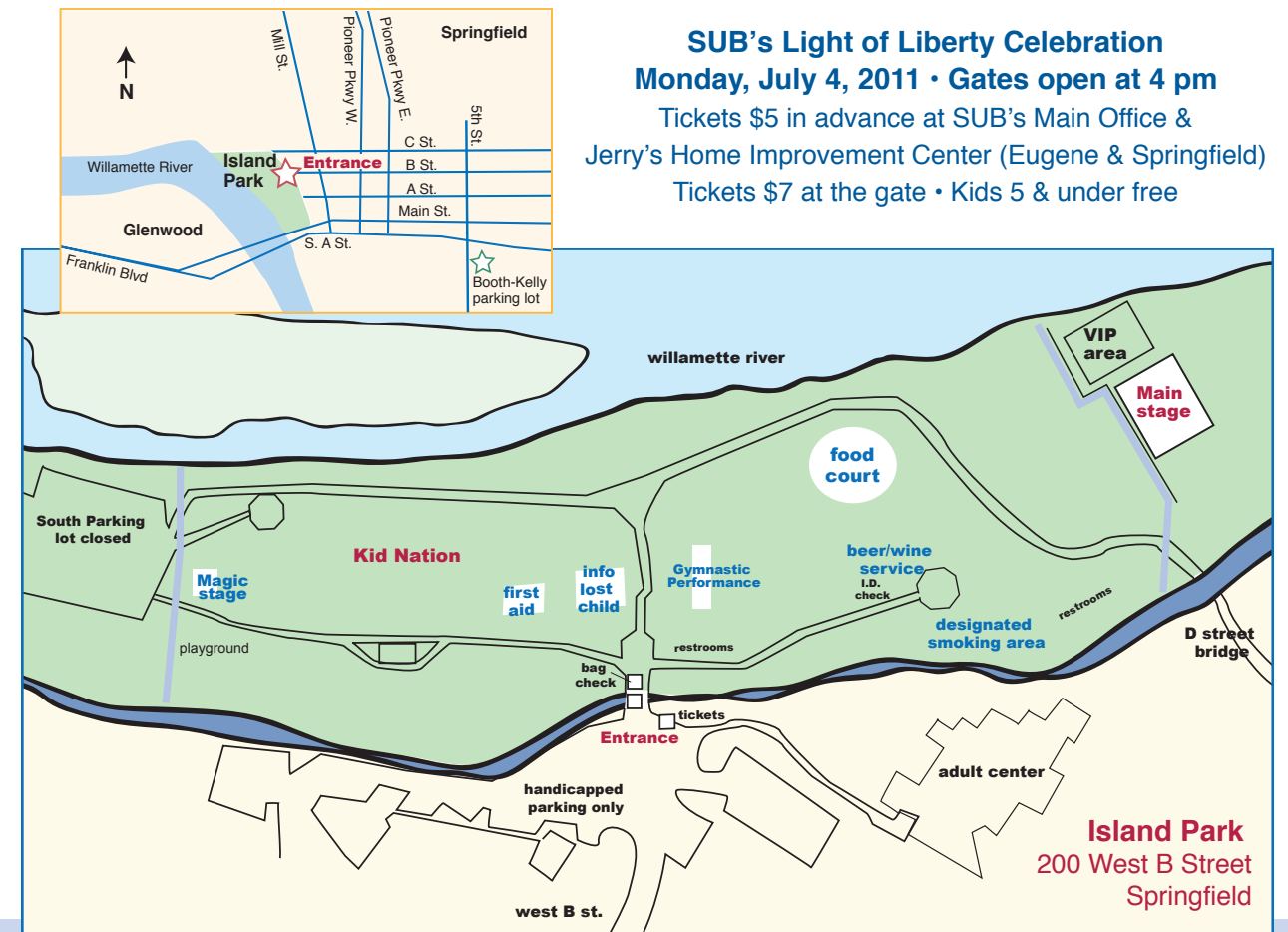
