

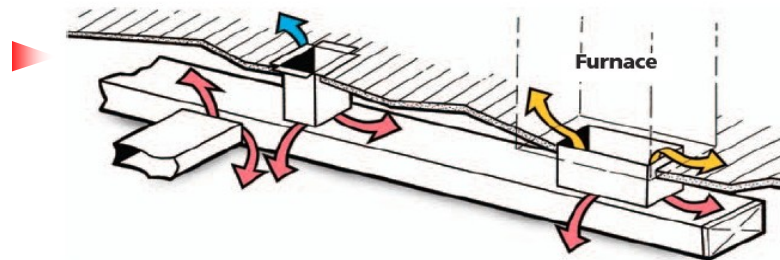
Properly sealed ducts are essential for energy efficient forced air systems and make a big difference in your comfort and health. Some of the benefits include:

- Plenum (furnace-duct) connection points.
- Boot (main duct and register) connection points.
- Branch duct connection points.

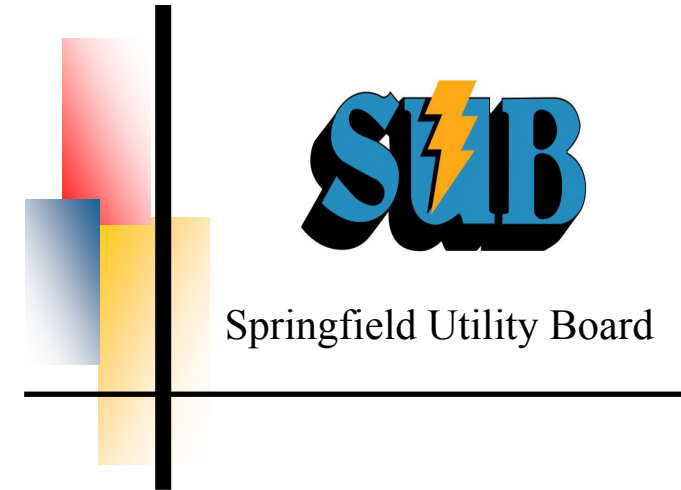


Crossover duct

Double wide homes have crossover ducts to take heated air from one side of the home to the other. Crossover ducts can be a major source of air leakage.

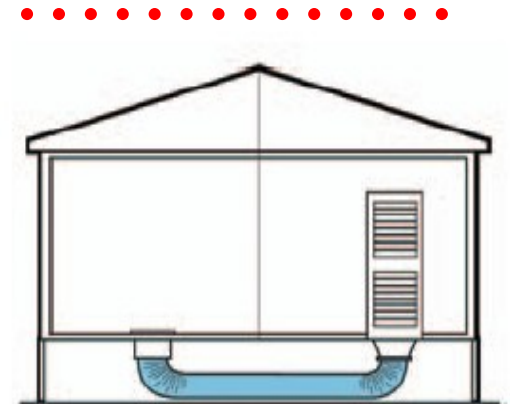

WHAT IS SUB'S DUCT SEALING PROGRAM?

Studies show the average duct system loses 20% to 40% of its heating energy through leaks. Springfield Utility Board's duct testing and sealing program is designed to increase comfort and provide energy savings to SUB customers at minimal or no cost.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE?

This program is available for Springfield Utility Board (SUB) customers with manufactured home that heat with an electric forced air furnace or heat pump system. Customers with gas heated homes are not eligible.

WHAT IS AVAILABLE TO SUB CUSTOMERS?

- SUB will pay up to \$200 for duct testing and sealing for PTCS qualified systems.
- Customer is responsible for any test only fees.

For duct sealing, repairs or rebuilds that exceed the incentive amount, there are three payment options available.

1. Single payment –The customer may pay the balance due directly to the contractor in a single payment **OR**;
2. (12) Twelve monthly payments added to SUB bill (Subject to prior Utility approval). SUB shall pay directly to the contractor the balance due, up to a maximum of \$300 **OR**;
3. Zero-interest loan- (Subject to prior loan approval through 1st Tech Credit Union) The customer may apply, through SUB, for a zero percent (%) loan to finance the balance due beyond the SUB incentive. The maximum loan amount is \$850; maximum loan term is two (2)years or 24 months.

Limited Income Program

For pre approved and qualified participants in SUB's Limited Income Program SUB provides a grant of up to \$500 for testing, sealing & minor repairs. Payment by SUB for repairs that exceed the grant amount of \$500 **MUST BE PRE-APPROVED BY AN AUTHORIZED SUB REPRESENTATIVE.**



PROGRAM STEPS

- ⇒ Customer must contact SUB prior to contacting contractor to confirm eligibility to participate in the Program.
 - A) Regular Income customers may prequalify for financing options at this time.
 - B) If applying for Limited Income program; complete & sign application.
- ⇒ Customer returns signed duct testing and sealing authorization.
- ⇒ Upon approval, customer contacts contractor from SUB approved Contractor List.
- ⇒ Contractor tests the system for leaks and makes recommendations.
- ⇒ If cost exceeds SUB incentive, customer selects one of the three payment options.
- ⇒ Upon completion of work, the customer is invoiced—SUB pays the incentive direct to the contractor.
