

Residential Backflow Testing Program

Springfield Utility Board is currently providing an opportunity for customers to participate in a Residential Backflow Testing Program that would assist customers in the completion of their required annual backflow assembly testing, without the burden of contacting and scheduling a certified testing contractor themselves. Residential customers may choose to have SUB arrange for your backflow assembly(s) to be tested annually by an independent contractor certified as a Backflow Assembly Tester in the State of Oregon and for SUB to act as their backflow test billing service.

In accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule 333-061-0070 promulgated by the Oregon Health Authority Public Health Division all approved backflow prevention assemblies must be maintained and tested at least annually to protect the public water system against contamination.

If you choose this option;

- SUB's Water Service Center will schedule the testing by an approved, licensed independent contractor.
- You don't need to be home during the test. However, you must make sure the backflow device is accessible.
- A testing fee of \$29 per assembly will be added to your water bill each year that you participate in the program.
- Test results will be left at your door. If the assembly passes the inspection, you are done for the year.
- If repairs are needed, the testing contractor will notify you. You may contract with the tester to complete all necessary repairs, or you may choose a different contractor. Repairs are billed directly by the tester and won't appear on your SUB statement. Note that for your protection, and to protect the community's water supply, all repairs must be completed within 10 working days of the failed test.
- If you do not have a backflow assembly on your underground sprinkler system, you need one! It's required, and it's important to ensure your drinking water is protected. Please call SUB's Water Service Center for assistance at the number below.

Repairs are separate from assembly testing charges. The testing contractor will notify you if repairs or replacement are needed. At that time, you may contract with the tester to complete all necessary repairs, or you may contact another contractor of your choice. In such event the tester repairing your assembly will bill you directly (repairs costs will not appear on your SUB bill). All repairs must be completed within 10 working days of the failed test.
