

Springfield Utility Board's Interconnection Policy

Indemnification Form

Springfield Utility Board's Interconnection Policy (adopted by the Board on February 12, 2008), requires that SUB staff receive written agreement with a customer prior to interconnecting generation.

SUB's Net Metering agreements or other agreements are updated from time to time. During the time that updates and legal review occurs, SUB may receive application to interconnect with SUB's system. This indemnification form is intended to be used as a temporary agreement in order to accommodate customer requests until a net metering agreement or other agreement is signed.
